Cabernet Franc was harvested in the Eger winegrowing region, near Nagytálya village, from Nagyaszú single vineyard.

TASTING NOTES

A pale enough ruby colour. In the nose intense earthiness, poppy seeds and other black spices, pepper, a little cassis. In the mouth large body, beautiful ripeness, wide, thick red wine. Long sips, delicious tannins, nice maturation, a kind of creamy feel, leather, sweet spices, plum jam and other dark flesh fruits. Exciting, multi-layered wine from Eger. A perfect match to peppery, spicy game dishes and steaks.

Earthiness, spices, creaminess.
