

Tokaji Hárslevelű "Lapis" 2019

The grape was harvested from the single vineyard Lapis, in Bodrogkeresztúr village. It contains 100% Hárslevelű. The old vines were harvested on 18th September 2019. Tank fermentation and 400 liters acacia barrel aging. Bottled on 17th August 2020.

TASTING NOTES

Straw yellow colour. Delicate floral, barrel-aged, perfumed bouquet with pears, quince, and medlar fragrance. A full-bodied palate with fine residual sugar and balanced acidity. Salty, long, fleshy richness, lots of honey-sweet, ripe yellow fleshy fruit, pears and the subtle play of the high-quality barrel complete the taste of the wine.

Perfumed, meaty, full-bodied.
